WHAT IS YOUTH AT CONFERENCE?

Youth at Conference works to include a youth presence in the work of the General Meeting of BC Conference. The goals are:

- **To provide youth attending conference with access to the skills, resources, information, and people which will enable them to participate fully in the Conference General Meeting as voting delegates**
- **To provide an opportunity for youth to build community and networks with one another from across BC Conference**
- **To be a presence of energy, passion and creativity for the annual meeting.**

Each Presbytery is invited to choose 2 youth to attend youth at conference and to appoint them as Voting Delegates. There will be a charge of \$100 per youth to offset some of the additional costs of overnight accomodation while meeting in Penticton. Our hope is that each presbytery will be able to provide funding for the 2 youth from their presbytery to attend. The travel costs of each voting delegate will be covered by the budget for the General Meeting.

THE PLAN: Once delegates are chosen for the programme, we will host 2 Video Conference calls which will be an orientation to the programme! Youth at Conference will begin at 3 pm on Thrusday, May 31st in Penticton. It will conclude on Sunday, June 3rd after the Celebration of Minstry Service. Once youth have registered both online and with the registration form attached, all their travel arrangements will be organized by the Conference Office (we will be in touch). It is important to know that being chosen to be a part of this event requires that participants are committing to being a part of the entire event and to the pre-event video conference calls. It is not possible for youth delegates to arrive late or leave early. Once the general meeting begins on Thursday, May 31st at 6:45 pm all Youth will be integrated into the regular meeting of BC Conference, participating as regular delegates and sitting at table groups. There may be times during the business that the youth delegates will have other responsibilities within their own programme and as such, may leave for short periods of time. We will be staying in private dorm accomodation at the International Hostel in Penticton, BC. We will return there each night for programme and community.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE A PRESBYTERY: Each presbytery in BC Conference is responsible for choosing 2 youth (ages 13-18) to attend. Each presbytery has a different way of choosing youth to come. Some will simply choose their youth reps and others will open up a process for youth to apply to attend. It is required that each presbytery go through some kind of process and have 2 voting delegates attend on behalf of all the youth in their presbytery. Please pass this information on to your presbytery youth worker, coordinator, Youth Committee, or other body that will be handling the selection process. It is hoped that each presbytery will pay the \$100 accomodation fee for each of their voting youth delegates. If this is a hardship please let us know and we'll see how we can help.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE A YOUTH AND YOU'VE BEEN CHOSEN:

- Please register online at www.bc.united-church.ca. During the registration process you will be directed to this form, or you are welcome to fill out this one and mail, email, or fax it in to the BC Conference Office (numbers are on the form)
- Once we receive your registration forms, we will be contacting you directly to arrange your travel
- Cost for youth at Conference is \$100 per youth. Either include a cheque made out to BC Conference, pay online by credit card, or have your Presbytery submit payment on your behalf.
